While 2021 was another covid year for us, we worked really hard to ensure that schools are properly prepared to welcome back the many thousands of students. We have set a new bar in rebuilding 45 schools and 5 libraries across Indonesia. Together with your support we raised more than IDR 21 billion, which allowed us to build back faster and increase the number of rebuilt schools per year.

In September 2021, the government finally started to slowly re-open all schools, still following a very strict protocol with limited school hours & a class shifting system. Only time will tell how this long period of limited access to education will impact our children, especially those in remote areas. Many have raised their concerns on how these children will further fall behind or leave school altogether. Online learning remains a great challenge in these remote areas that we serve. Therefore, our teams on the ground keep collecting data and feedback from the field so we can seek solutions on how to improve the situation in case of future events.



2022 will start with a bang. We are introducing a new **financial management training** to our HHI rebuilt schools. Keeping each school properly maintained and seeking financial independence are two of the major concerns of our rebuilt schools. This training helps the school management team to prepare & plan ahead.



2021 achievements


With a minimum of one capacity building per year, students and teachers continue to develop their skills further. In 2021, **258 students** have received our WASH training
